said He:

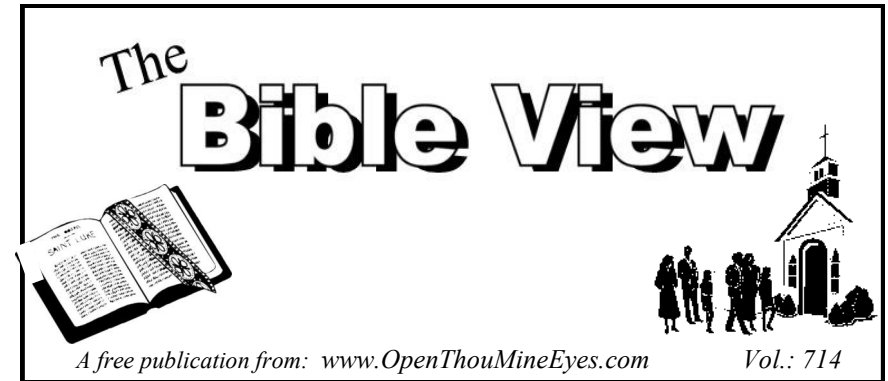
Then I am sure that He sent Him

- ◆ Millions of people will live a life sinning and defiant to God because they never heard the truth nor ever saw a good Christian example. *“And Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest? 31 And he said, How can I, except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him.” Acts 8:30*
- ◆ Millions do not know what the Bible teaches as they have never heard biblical truths nor have seen one living the way God commands.
