

Why Our Bible Is Changed

"The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever." Isa. 40:8

God promises many times in the King James Bible that we will always have a copy of his Word. Satan, of course, cannot get God to break His promise, but He has done all he could to confuse people about what God had said. Even in the Garden of Eden, Satan controlled the serpent to confuse Eve of what God actually said: "... Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?"

Satan knew what God commanded Eve to do, but by changing and challenging what God said, he got her to break God's commandment. Because of this confusion, the first sin was committed, and we have been paying for it ever since.

Satan knows the value and importance of God's Word and has never stopped confusing man with what God has said. We have one true Word of God, and it is preserved exactly how it was given to the leaders, kings, prophets, disciples, and scribes to whom God dictated it. In the English language, it is the King James Bible. It is the version Satan hates the most because he knows how pure and powerful it is.

To this day, many believe Satan is still working to put doubt on what God has said. Surely, he is behind the corruption in over 400

hundred different English "bible" perversions. Each one claim to make it easier and more precise, but each is changing biblical doctrines and principles by deleting verses, and adding and changing words. Catholics have the doctrine the way they want in their Douay-Rheims, Confraternity, Revised Standard Version, New International Version, New Jerusalem, and many other versions. Religions that do not want you to know that Christ is the son of God, that His shed blood is what saves you, and that good works cannot save one from Hell have their editions also. They

"Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. 6 Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar."

Prov. 30:5-6

Proverbs 30 was written by a man of which little is known, other than what he tells us about himself. Agur (Proverbs 30:1) confesses to being a rude, uncouth fellow (Prov. 30:2) without many of the behaviors, learning, and morals that most have (Prov. 30:2-4). Nevertheless, this man did learn something that the majority of the citizens of this world have not understood.

Agur somehow learned and believed that God's Word was preserved, available, and could be understood even to people like him. He recognized that God's words were "pure" (Prov. 30:5) and not contaminated by man's influence.

Since the very first people, Adam and Eve, were on this Earth, what God had said has been changed. Satan was the first to misquote God's Word and even get Eve to question what the Creator said: "... Yea, hath God said..." (Gen. 3:1). Since that time, there have been many people causing doubt, adding, and deleting words from what God originally said.

In English alone, there are over 400 different versions of God's Word. God certainly does not need help in saying what he wants us to know, and He has not changed His truths. Those authors and "translators" are doing what God has forbidden to (Duet. 4:2, 12:32, Rev. 22:18-19) be done to His Word.

For one that has investigated some of the modern perversions of God's Word, it will quickly be recognized that they are not "making it easier" to understand," as they would like people to believe. They all are changing

the meaning of the Scriptures. God's truths are altered and most likely by the same influence that confused Eve: Satan.

English-speaking people do not need His Word dumbed down. They need to understand their language better and allow the Holy Spirit to show them what the Bible says. It is the

Spirit of God that shows anyone what His Word means any way.

Read and believe the Word of God that has been preserved for you. Although it is kept pure in the major languages also, for English-speaking people, it is the King

James Bible they should only be reading. Accept no counterfeited substitute (not even the altered New King James Version).

Be like Agur. Recognize God's Word is kept for you to read, learn, and obey. It is "pure" and undefiled. Do not allow anyone to add or subtract from what God wants you to know.

Yet, that is what is happening to God's love letter to mankind. Men with deceptive purposes are taking God's Words and changing thousands of words in the Bible. In many cases, it is tens of thousands of words that are altered.
